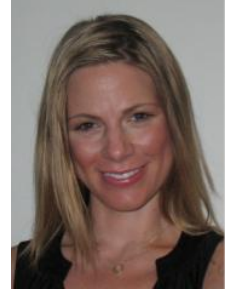


Third Party Information Security Risk Management Program
